

## **Patient Instructions for Stool Collection**

Your provider has ordered tests that use special vials for collection. After collection, please deliver the vials to your provider's office or one of the below listed Laboratories as soon as possible. Please call the Laboratory if you have any questions. Multiple collections for the same test should be collected 24 hours apart.

## Write on EACH Vial

- 1. Complete Name (First and Last Name)
- 2. Date of Birth
- 3. Date and Time of Collection
- Select an area of the stool that is bloody, slimy, or watery.
- Collect the Empty Vial first to prevent contamination. Avoid mixing up the caps and vials. Using the scoop in the cap, add stool to the vial until the liquid reaches the <u>fill line</u> on the side of the bottle. Tighten the cap, shake firmly to mix. It is important that the stool does <u>not</u> have urine or water. This will affect the results of the test.

\*\*\*Do not drink/eat the liquid that is in the vials. If drank/eaten by accident contact POISON CONTROL immediately 1-800-222-1222\*\*\*
